

PROTOCOL FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION WIND FARM, SILTON

Members of the public who have made representations on planning applications have the opportunity to address the Development Control Committee on the application.

Public participation time is limited so if there are several objectors or supporters they will be asked to agree a spokesperson to represent their views. They should confine their questions and comments to planning issues and any matters which they feel have not been covered in the officer's report.

The Chairman of Development Control Committee has discretion on who may speak at the meeting.

Order of Presentation

1. The Case Officer presents the report on the application.
2. Comment by Statutory bodies (eg CPRE, Highways Authority, Environment Agency)
3. Silton Parish Council 5 minutes
Bourton Parish Council 5 minutes
Gillingham Town Council 5 minutes
4. Presentation by Save our Silton (SOS) 20 minutes
5. Comments by members of the public 3 minutes each
6. Comments by Local District Councillors 3 minutes each
7. Presentation by the applicant and/or their agent 20 minutes
8. Questions to any speaker by Committee Members

LUNCH

9. Members' debate followed by vote.

The Chairman has absolute discretion on who can speak at the meeting and will determine whether any extension to speaking times will be permitted.

Members of the Committee may ask questions of the applicant, agent or any supporter/objector who has addressed the Committee or question officers on issues that have arisen out of the public speaking.

The Committee will then debate and vote on the application. No further public participation is permitted.
